



Your tricky legal questions answered

The Motor Insurers' Bureau (MIB) only compensates victims of negligent untraced or uninsured drivers of motor vehicles, so unfortunately not. The other Government compensating body, the Criminal Injuries Compensation Authority (CICA), is highly unlikely to compensate you, as a "crime of violence" is required to have been committed in order

'You will need tdo claim against the kid's parents'

I suggest that you see if you can claim against the parents' household contents insurance. These policies often cover negligent acts of members of the household, even away from the home. Therefore I would write to the parents and enquire as to the existence of such insurance. assuming you have the contact details of the boy.



'Hit by kid on an electric scoot'
